

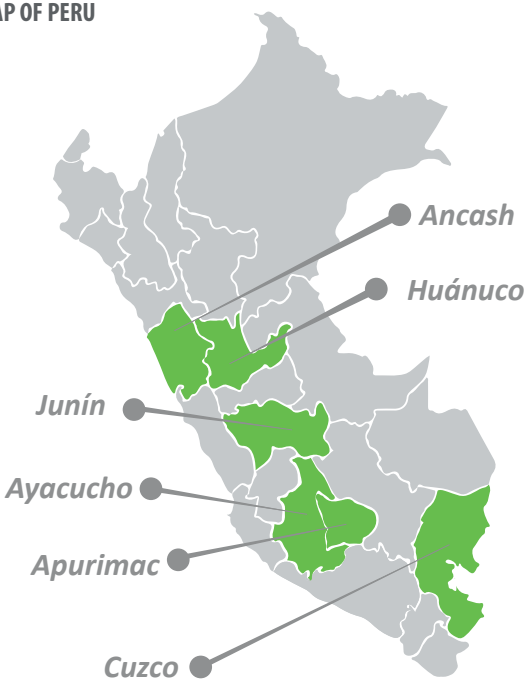

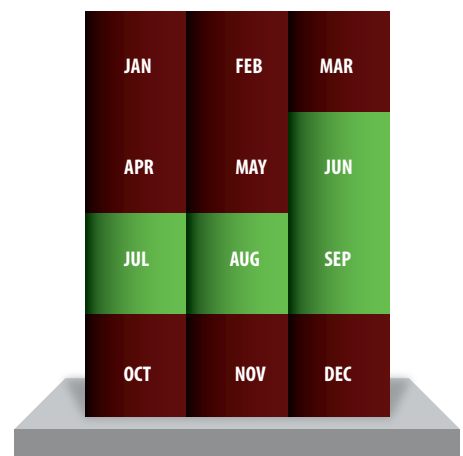
**GEOGRAPHICAL DISTRIBUTION**

**STATIONARY AVAILABILITY**

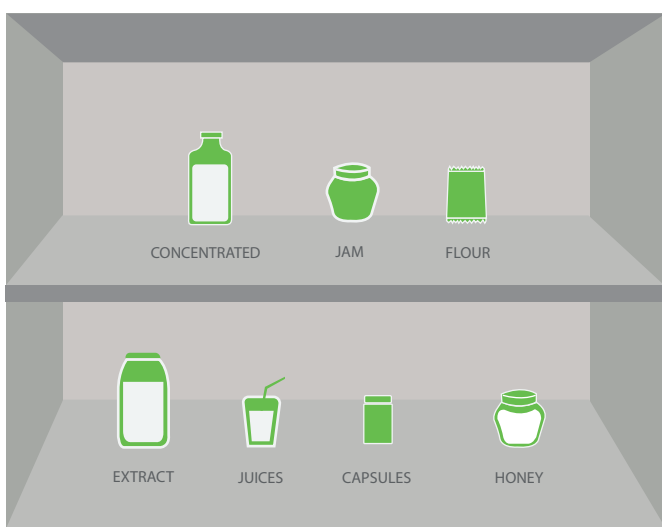
